At our medical facility, you can receive your seasonal and H1N1 flu vaccine with confidence from our highly trained staff along with an on-site physician.¹

Everyone is welcome, including non-patients!

H1N1 Vaccine²

Our office has been approved and registered as an H1N1 vaccine administration site through the Virginia Department of Health.

As of Dec 9th, we will begin to offer this vaccine to the general public through our scheduled clinic hours.

The high risk groups for H1N1 still remains as listed:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and medical services personnel
- Individuals between the ages of 6 months - 24 years old
- Individuals who are at a higher risk to H1N1 due to chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems

We are able to offer 2 varieties of this vaccine, a preservative-free injection and an intranasal spray. Please specify which you'd be interested in when arriving at the clinic.

FAQ'S

Will the seasonal flu vaccine also protect against the 2009 H1N1 flu?

The seasonal flu vaccine is not expected to protect against the 2009 H1N1 flu.

Can the seasonal vaccine and the 2009 H1N1 vaccine be given at the same time?

Inactivated 2009 H1N1 vaccine can be administered at the same visit as any other vaccine, including pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine. Live 2009 H1N1 vaccine can be administered at the same visit as any other live or inactivated vaccine EXCEPT seasonal live attenuated influenza vaccine, which can be given at least 30 days after.
